- Anthem Blue Cross' extensive network of over 60,000 doctors and other providers.
- Access to savings on vision, fitness, alternative health care, weight management, books and many more!
- Informed Health Line – Call our toll-free number to talk to registered nurses. They can share information on a range of healthy topics\*.
- Travel Assistance Services and Worldwide Medical Coverage while traveling or studying abroad\*\*.
- Copay for pharmacy at in-network pharmacies with an unlimited maximum. Out-of-network pharmacy services covered at 50%.

- **All off-campus services within a 50 mile radius of the Student Health Service require a referral from the Student Health Service.**

### Who is Eligible?

All registered students at UCSB are automatically eligible and are enrolled in the UC Student Health Insurance Plan (UC SHIP) and charged a health insurance premium on their registration bill unless they apply and are approved for a waiver due to having equivalent insurance.
