What is NOT covered under the UCSB GHI Plan?

The following procedures that may be performed as a component of a gender reassignment are considered as cosmetic under the current GHI Plan (not an all-inclusive list; see also [CPB 0031 - Cosmetic Surgery](#)):

Abdominoplasty	Chin/nose implants	Hair transplantation	Neck tightening	Removal of redundant skin
Blepharoplasty	Collagen injections	Jaw reduction/contouring	Nipple reconstruction	Rhinoplasty
Brow lift	Construction of clitoral hood	Lip reduction	Nose implants	Tracheal shave
Calf implants	Forehead lift	Liposuction	OTC drugs for hair loss or growth	Travel expenses
Cheek/malar implants	Hair removal (e.g. electrolysis)	Mastopexy	Pectoral implants	Voice therapy/voice lessons

*Some of the above services are included as part of other surgical procedures (e.g. construction of clitoral hood & nipple reconstruction).
