LiveHealth Online comes in. Using LiveHealth Online, you can have a video visit with a board-certified doctor or a mental health professional from your smartphone, tablet, or computer with a webcam. It's an easy, convenient, and secure option when your student health center is closed.



5 steps to getting a video visit with a doctor

Secure your connection

When you're ready to see a doctor, you can connect by computer, tablet, or smartphone with internet and video capabilities. Go to livehealthonline.com or download the mobile app.





2 Sign up - Register using UC SHIP

From the health plan menu select "Anthem Blue Cross (CA)"
Enter your Subscriber ID found on your UC SHIP insurance card

- -You can access this using the StudentHealth mobile app
- -Your Subscriber ID begins with the characters "XDP"

In addition to seeing a medical doctor, you can consult with a board-certified psychiatrist or behavioral health counselor online within two weeks.^{1,2}

If you're over 18 years old, you can get medication support to help you manage a mental health condition. To schedule your appointment call 1-888-548-3432.





3 Choose the doctor you want to see

You don't need an appointment to see a doctor. They're always available to assess your condition and send a prescription to the pharmacy you choose, if needed. It's a great option when you have common health problems like pink eye, a cold, a fever, allergies, or a sinus infection. When you log in to LiveHealth Online, you'll see the different doctors available to you. Usually you'll be connected to a doctor in minutes.

4 Verify your information

After you select a doctor, you'll be asked one more time to verify your insurance information and confirm your copay, if any. If you have a copay, you'll be asked to enter your credit card information. If you have UC SHIP insurance, please refer to your plan documents for your benefits and copay for LiveHealth Online.

5 Complete a post-visit survey

At the end of your visit, you'll be asked to fill out a short survey and share your medical records with your student health center. Please make sure to enter your student health center's email address so your care can be coordinated appropriately.
