**3. SHAC Charter:**

- a. Changes were briefly reviewed. Notably, charter has been updated to lower the barrier to inclusion and entry for students looking to speak on their student health experiences or voice opinions related to SHS.
- b. S. Stephenson made the 1st motion to approve the charter, G. Tsouloufas seconded this motion.
  - i. The updated 2026 charter is approved by the committee.

#### **4. Membership Admission Process:**

- a. Consists of explanation and purpose of SHAC.
- b. Non-endorsed vs. endorsed students
  - i. Why restrict people who have Student Health experiences?
  - ii. This process has more flexibility built into it.
  - iii. Even if the student doesn't wish to become a formal member, they can attend the meetings.
    - 1. Helps with overall student advocacy because a lot of students have opinions/experiences to share.
- c. Maybe the committee wants to market this to all students.
  - i. Could only be for the better of Student Health & Improvement.
  - ii. Use "listserv" emails to get the word out to the rest of campus.
- d. C. Kaulback envisions this as a PDF that will be uploaded to the website once it passes approval.
- e. G. Tsouloufas gave 1st motion to approve, S. Stephenson seconded this motion.
  - i. Membership Admission Process is approved by committee.

#### **5. Awareness Campaign for Local Healthcare Benefits**

- a. This is a series of materials that is meant to target students that have UC SHIP, Waived, or GAP and make them aware of what services they have coverage for.
  - i. Just better understanding of healthcare literacy for students.
  - ii. Trying to make it as palatable and thorough as possible.

b. A. Srinivasan, EVPLA Health Care Initiatives Coordinator spoke on her work done for this project.

- i. This campaign has been put on the Student Health Instagram.
- ii. Maybe we can try to make the content more digestible because there is a lot of info on one sheet.
- iii. Next time C. Kaulback will send the marketing material to the Dean of Students.
  1. Calls for collaboration with different groups and can get pushed to more places to get more engagement.

c. Rapid Fire Q&A with SHS Providers

- i. This will give students the opportunity to be more familiar with providers at SHS.
- ii. Have already done it with Nurse Practitioner, Alana Mendoza and Family Medicine Practitioner, Miguel Pedroza.
- iii. Hoping to mash the two together and post to Instagram.
  1. Will be finalized in the next few weeks.
- iv. Doing some of the Building Entry staff would also be great as well or even a variety of different SHS staff.
  1. G. Rodriguez, Building Entry, would be a great person to interview for this.
- v. Also, it would be a good idea to get some of the nurses to speak on travel because students always have a lot of questions on that.
