California's COVID-19 Exposure Notification System

Protect your friends, family, and community

- CA Notify is a free exposure notification system for smartphones, to alert you if you've been exposed to COVID-19.
- CA Notify is easy to use, private, secure, and 100% voluntary.
- It's available for both iPhone and Android phones.
- CA Notify helps keep communities safe from COVID-19 by alerting people if they need to get tested or stay home.



How CA Notify Works

- Smartphone users activate CA Notify on their device (both iPhone and Android).
- CA Notify tracks your phone's proximity to other phones (those with CA Notify activated). If someone tests positive for COVID-19 and chooses to share their status with CA Notify, that person's recent contacts will be notified and alerted about whether they should get tested and stay home.
- CA Notify is free, anonymous, and voluntary. It doesn't use GPS, doesn't track your identity or immigration status, and doesn't know your specific location.
- Even if you're fully vaccinated, you can still contract and spread COVID-19. Help protect your friends, family, and community by activating CA Notify.



How does it help?

- CA Notify helps alert people if they've been exposed to COVID-19, so they can get tested, monitor their symptoms, and take precautions.
- Even those who are fully vaccinated can still potentially spread COVID-19.
- CA Notify works faster and more efficiently than standard contact tracing - and can capture possible exposures at large mixing events such as concerts and conferences – where contact tracing is difficult.



Heading back to campus? Activate CA Notify

- CA Notify can help reduce COVID-19 spread on campuses because it takes action more quickly than traditional contact tracing. If one student tests positive, they can quickly inform their recent contacts of possible exposure via CA Notify.
- We all want to be as safe as possible back on campus. We encourage eligible students, faculty, and staff to activate CA Notify – even if they've been fully vaccinated.



Going to a concert? Activate CA Notify

- CA Notify is an important tool as Californians head back out to concerts, conferences, and stadium events this fall.
- At large mixing events, CA Notify can track COVID-19 exposure where traditional contact tracing may be unable.



Getting Ready for a Trip? Activate CA Notify

- California is an international destination, and Californians also love to travel. Help keep California and your community safe by activating CA Notify whenever you are in California.
- Even if you're vaccinated, you can potentially contract and spread COVID-19 – especially with variants traveling quickly around the globe.
